Please reinstate order No. SWD-135, dated September 15, 1973, which granted Union Oil Company of California permission to dispose of salt water into the above well. At the time the order was granted SWD operations were ceased due to reservoir difficulties. Injection of salt water into the above well is presently necessary due to an OCD request to cease disposal into the 5-1/2" x 8-5/8" annulus of Federal "A" No. 1, Section 12, T-15-S R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
