Re: Amendment of Division Order No. SWD-140

Dear Mr. Wacker:

Reference is made to your application dated September 27, 1989, to amend Division Order No. SWD-140, which order authorized the use of the Jicarilla "30" Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 30, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as a disposal well in the Mesaverde formation from approximately 5171 feet to 5432 feet, to expand the injection interval to include the entire Mesaverde formation from approximately 4846 feet to 5586 feet.


In reviewing the application, the Division finds that:

- 1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations.
- 2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified; and
- 3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all the requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met.
- 4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

You are therefore authorized to utilize the Jicarilla "30" Well No. 1 (as described above) to dispose of water into the Mesaverde formation from a depth of approximately 4846 feet to 5586 feet.

All other provisions contained in Order No. SWD-140 shall remain in full force and effect.
