SUBJECT: SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELL

ORDER NO. SWD-148

THE APPLICATION OF KLABZUBA, MUNSON,
AND SEAMAN FOR A SALT WATER DISPOSAL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) Klabzuba, Munson, and Seaman, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on August 24, 1973, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its White Well No. 2 located in Unit N of Section 18, Township 10 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.

The Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) of the Commission Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators, surface owners, and the New Mexico State Engineer Office have been duly notified; and
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 (C) will be met.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Klabzuba, Munson, and Seaman, is hereby authorized to complete its White Well No. 2 located in Unit N of Section 18, Township 10 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the San Andres formation at approximately 2186 feet to approximately 2289 feet through 2 3/8-inch casing with a packer set at approximately 2150 feet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary and convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted in the interest of conservation. That applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
