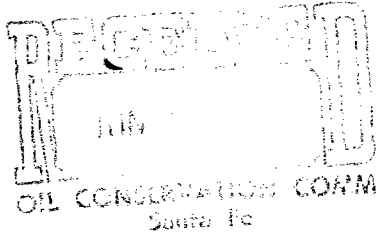

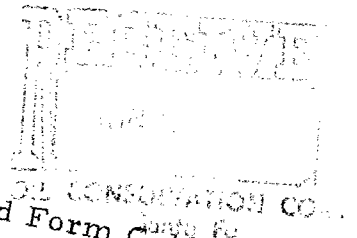
Gentlemen:

The referenced well is currently an approved salt water disposal well in the Abo zone at 9122-9200 open hole. Prior to conversion to a SWD well it had produced oil from the San Andres formation through perfs at 5025-30; 5034-40 and 5050-59 until October, 1971 when production declined to an uneconomical rate and it was converted to an Abo disposal well. When the well was converted to an Abo disposal well, the San Andres perfs were not squeezed and a packer was set at 6697 with 2-7/8" tubing, allowing the disposed water to gravity feed into the Abo zone. We are presently disposing approximately 4000 bbls. of water per month into this well.

In order to comply with your memorandum of March 11, 1974, regarding disposal and injection wells, we respectfully request permission to pull the packer and tubing and re-set the packer above the open San Andres perfs. In so doing, we would be able to regularly observe and report leakage of the injection tubing, packer or casing and install a leak detection device.

Even though the San Andres perfs would be exposed to injection water, we do not believe any of the water would gravity into this zone as it is very tight. This reservoir has been depleted and there are no other wells in this area that produce from the San Andres formation.
