Waterflood operations have been discontinued on our Teague Simpson Waterflood Unit. The last two producing wells, No's 6 and 7, will be plugged and abandoned in the Teague Simpson and recompleted to another zone.

In this connection, your administrative approval is requested to redesignate the C. E. LaMunyon No. 9, water injection well, to salt water disposal well in order that produced water on the LaMunyon Lease may be disposed of into the Teague Simpson.

The attached plat shows the pertinent Gulf wells as well as the only other producing wells in the Teague Simpson Pool, which are operated by the Carter Foundation Production Company.

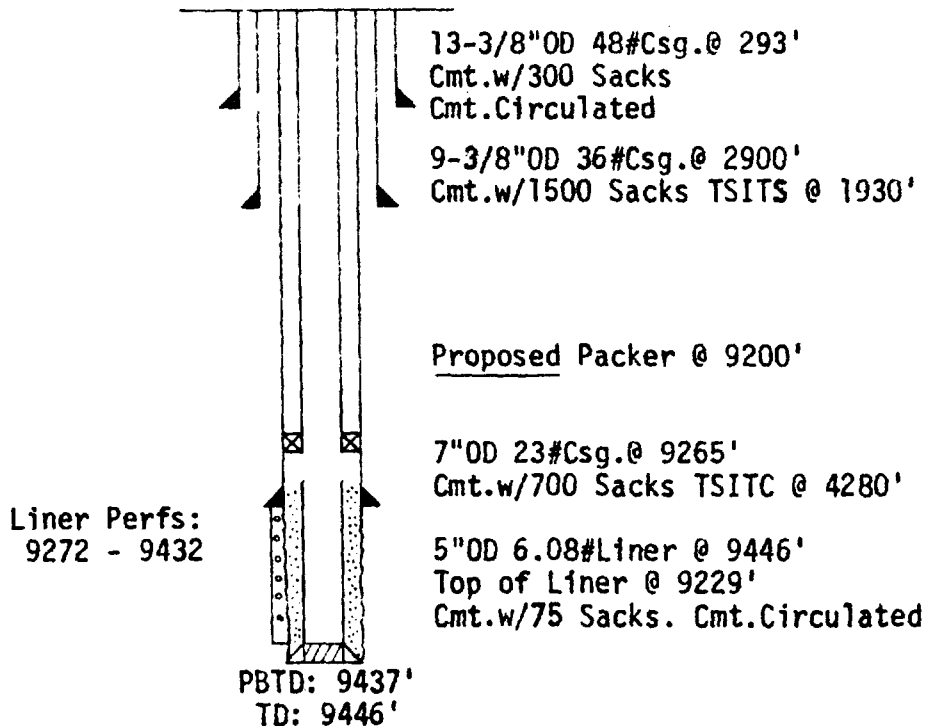

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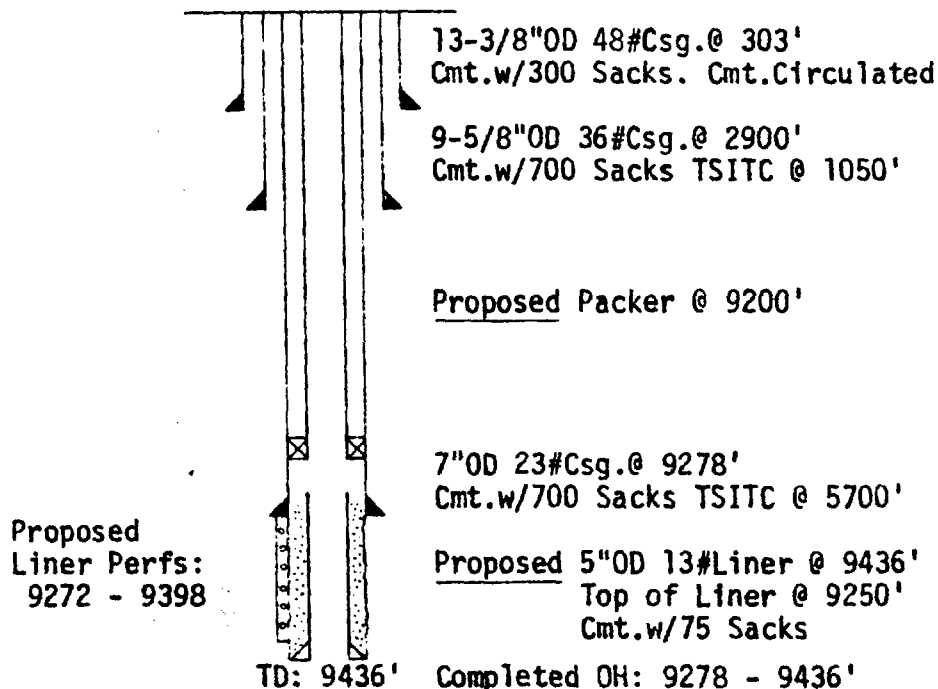
WELL NO. 8
