

Gentlemen:

Convert Queen "B" Well No. 36 to Salt Water Disposal

In response to our phone conversation, today, concerning our application to convert Conoco's Queen "B" Well No. 36 to SWD, the following information is furnished as it pertains to Form C-108:

- VIII - The lower Wolfcamp, into which we will inject, is Dolomite, white to tan, fine to coarse crystalline with some vugular porosity. The depths of the formations and perforated intervals are shown on the copy of the log section attached to our application.

- XII - There are no known sources of underground drinking water in the area of this application, not even a windmill within a mile, therefore no evidence of open faults or any other hydrologic connection to any underground source of drinking water.
