

APPLICATION


Comes, now, ENSERCH EXPLORATION, INC., by and through its undersigned attorneys and hereby applies to the Oil Conservation Division for approval of a salt water disposal well and in support thereof would show:

1. That applicant seek authority to utilize its Scott Federal No. 2 Well located 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 20, Township 4 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., North Peterson Field, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, to dispose of produced salt water.
2. The applicant proposes to utilize said well to dispose of produced salt water into the Montoya Formation by injection through perforations from 8722 feet to 8772 feet.
3. That approval of the subject application will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells and otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing before one of the Division's duly appointed examiner and, that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order approving the application.
