Dear Mr. Stumhoffer:


Reference is made to your request dated August 17, 1994 to increase the surface injection pressure on the above referenced well. This request is based on a step rate tests conducted on this well on June 26, 1990. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Well and Location	Maximum Injection Surface Pressure
Central EK Queen Unit Tract 6 Well No. 1 1980' FSL & 660' FWL Unit L, Section 9, Township 18 South, Range 34 East	1430 PSIG
This well located in Lea County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
