

Administrative approval for the proposed disposal operation was recently given by the Oil Conservation Division Order referred to above. Your file will reflect that Yates Petroleum Corporation gave notice to the owner of the surface and all leasehold operators of wells within the area of review, as provided by the C-108. Yates Petroleum Corporation became concerned whether notice to the working interest owners in the well to be converted was necessary under the rules. Following my discussion with Mr. Taylor and yourself last week, Yates Petroleum Corporation decided to notify all working interest owners as a precautionary matter.

An affidavit reflecting this notification in accordance with Rule 1207 is enclosed for filing. Yates Petroleum Corporation will not take any action to convert the well to disposal for a period of 15 days from such mailing to give all working interest owners an opportunity to object. Please advise the undersigned if any objection is made on this application, and whether or not any further action is required of Yates Petroleum Corporation.
