VI. There are no wells penetrating the proposed depth interval within the area of review.

- VII. 1) The proposed average injection rate is estimated at 3500 bbls/day. The estimated maximum is 20,000 bbls/day. *1100 current volume*
- 2) The system will be closed.
- 3) The estimated maximum surface injection pressure is 1710 psi.
- 4) The source of injected fluid will be produced water from the Fruitland Coal formation.
- 5) Injection is for disposal purposes into a zone productive of oil and gas. The distance to the nearest well penetrating the proposed zones is greater than 5 miles. Chemical analysis of the zone formation water will be supplied when available.

VIII. The proposed injection zones are the Morrison and Entrada, both zones are sandstone. The Morrison interval is estimated @ 7540-8385' from G.L. (6060') having a thickness of 845'. The Entrada interval is estimated @ 8400-8550' from G.L. (6060') having a thickness of 150'.

The only overlying fresh water aquifer is the Ojo Alamo having an estimated base depth of 1150' from G.L. There is no fresh water known below the injection zone.

IX. The proposed stimulation program will consist of sand water fracturing of each interval using 1000 pounds of 20/40 sand per net foot of formation interval. Proppant concentration will be from 1/2 to 2 lbs./gal. The fracturing fluid will be a 40 lb./gal linear gel.

X. No logs or test data available at present.


XI. Currently there are no available analyses on water wells in this area.

XII. An examination of geologic and engineering data indicates no evidence of open faults or any other hydrologic connection between the disposal zone and any source of drinking water. This conclusion is based on proof of isolation between upper gas and oil bearing zones within the area of review.


