

Burr, Jr., telephone number (505)325-1702, has filed application with the Oil Conservation Division, Energy and Minerals Department, Santa Fe, New Mexico for authority to inject water in the Mesa Verde Formation (2704'-2746', subsurface) in the Noo Navajo #2 Well, located 330 FNL, 1750' FEL, Section 13, T20N, R6W, N.M.P.M., McKinley County, New Mexico.

The expected maximum injection rate is 700 Bbls. per day at a pressure of 541 P.S.I.

Interested parties must file objections or request for hearing with the Oil Conservation Division, P. O. Box 2088, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501 within 15 days.
