Dear Mr. Tipton:


Reference is made to your request dated May 18, 1995 to increase the surface injection pressure on the above referenced well. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on May 8, 1995. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Well and Location	Maximum Surface Injection Pressure
H.J. Loe Federal 'B' Well No.2 Unit Letter G, Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 12 West	630 psig

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
