
Pursuant thereto, please find enclosed the following:

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the captioned New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's Order dated September 4, 1996 authorizing Pogo to inject produced saltwater into its Diamond "34" State #1 Well, with such injection authority terminating one year after the effective date of such Order if the Operator had not commenced injection operations; provided that the Division can grant an extension if good cause is shown.

Due to the length of time that it took to acquire the necessary federal/state/private pipeline right-of-ways to transport produced water to the Diamond "34" State No. 1 Well, Pogo does not anticipate that it will have the pipelines installed and be injecting saltwater into the subject well by September 4, 1997.


In connection with the above, Pogo Producing Company respectfully requests a forty-five (45) day extension to the date that injection operations are to be commenced in the subject well.

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
