The proposed well, the Bobby Fee No. 1 is located 2252 feet from the south line and 990 feet from the west line, Section 25, Township 9 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico. Disposal water will be sourced from area wells producing from the Devonian formation. The disposal water will be injected into the Devonian formation at a depth 12,288'. A maximum surface pressure of 2458 psi, and a maximum rate of 10,000 BWP/D.
