RE: Amendment of Division Order SWD-416


Dear Mr. Biernbaum,

Reference is made to your request dated April 23, 1993, to amend SWD-416, to include the injection of acid gas into the Indian Basin Gas Com Well No. 1, located in Unit E of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 23 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Your request is hereby approved, subject to the following.

- 1) Volume of injected acid gas will be limited to 2,000 MSCFD consisting of approximately 50% H₂S and 50% CO₂ by volume.
- 2) Within 30 days of implementation of acid gas injection, the operator shall supply this office and the Artesia district office with an analysis of the injection stream.
- 3) The operator shall conduct a mechanical integrity test on an annual basis, and shall notify the Artesia district office prior to testing.

Division Order SWD-416 is hereby amended to include these conditions.
