

Yates Petroleum Corporation, 105 South Fourth Street, Artesia, NM 88210 has filed form C-108 (Application for Authorization to Inject) with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking administrative approval for an injection well. The proposed well, the "Handicapper SWD #1" located 660'N&L & 1980'E&L of Section 3, Township 10 South, Range 26 East of Chaves County, New Mexico, will be used for salt water disposal. Disposal waters from the Ordovician, Permian, Wolfcamp, and Abo will be re-injected into the Ordovician at a depth of 6,038'-6,268' with a maximum pressure of 1300 psi and a maximum rate of 5,000 BWPD.
