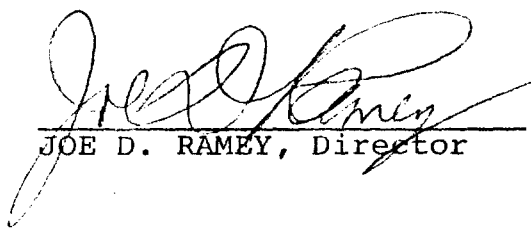

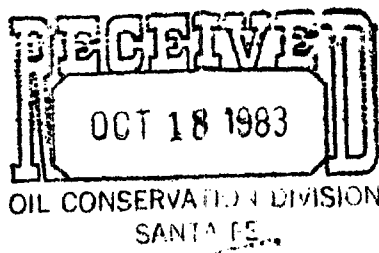

RE: Variance from Rule 309-A, Hanladdie WR State #3, K-6444

Dear Sir:

State Lease #K-6444 as shown on the attached plat is separated into different areas. Well #1 is located in the North area (1980 FSL & 1980 FWL Section 9-T14S-R33e) while the well #3 is located in the South area (2310 FNL & 2310 FWL Section 16-T14-T33E). We have constructed a tank battery near the well #1, in the north area. We now request that production from the well #3 be transported by pipeline from the south area, to the north area. This requires movement off lease, then back onto the same lease.

1. All production is from the same common source of supply.
2. Commingling of production from different leases will not result.
3. There will be no intercommunication of the handling, separating, treating, or storage facilities of different leases.

This exception is asked for because of the expense of building an additional tank battery on this lease. Also, more facilities would increase the environmental impact with respect to fire hazard, noise, and air pollution.
