The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle Ingle Wells Delaware production from the following leases:

Description: NW/4 NW/4; and,

Lease: Todd Federal - Lease No. NM 0544986
Description: S/2, NE/4, E/2 NW/4, SW/4 NW/4,

Both in Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each pool prior to commingling.


NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia District Office prior to implementation of the commingling process.

REMARKS: Commingled production shall be stored in a tank battery facility located in Unit Letter F of Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
