The proposed operation is described in detail on the attached diagrams.

A map is enclosed showing the lease numbers and location of all leases and wells that will contribute production to the proposed commingling/common storage facility. All unitized/communitized areas, producing zones/pools are also clearly illustrated.

A schematic diagram is also attached which clearly identifies all equipment that will be utilized.

The storage and measuring facility is located at SW-1/4, Sec.33, T20S, R20E, on lease No. NM 440627 EDDY County, New Mexico. BLM will be notified if there is any future change in the facility location.

The working interest owners have been notified of the proposal.


The proposed commingling of production is in the interest of conservation and will not result in reduced royalty or improper measurement of production.



This letter acknowledges the receipt of your administrative application dated August 1, 2001, to surface commingle Yates production on the Saladar Lease located in Section 33, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The Division received your application on August 9, 2001.

Our preliminary review indicates that the information provided in the application is not sufficient to process the administrative order. The following information is necessary:

- a) **Administrative Application Checklist**
- b) **Is the interest ownership (including royalty and overriding royalty) different between the Federal and fee wells. If so, please list all owners that were notified of your application.**
- c) **A schematic diagram of the tank battery.**

Since the submitted information is insufficient to review, the application was **Ruled Incomplete** on August 14, 2001. Please submit the above stated information by August 21, 2001.
