Description: E/2 SW/4 Sec. 19, T-17-S, R-29-E, NMPM,


both in Eddy County, New Mexico

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately  
metering the production from each lease prior to  
commingling.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in  
accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule  
309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the  
Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation  
of Commingling Facilities." It is the  
responsibility of the producer to notify the  
transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The original Administrative Order No. CTB-292  
approved the allocation of production to each  
lease be determined by well tests. This Order is being  
amended per your letter dated February 17, 1983, notifying  
the NMOCD of an additional well located on the State S-19  
Lease which has a diversity in the working interest  
ownership, see Rule 309-B.5.(b) of the NMOCD General Rules  
and Regulations. Also please submit to the Santa Fe Office  
a schematic diagram of the new commingling facility as soon  
as possible.
