Director Wrotenbery,

On November 30, 2001, Calpine Natural Company applied to complete the Roosevelt #1 No.1 (API No. 30-045-26458) for Salt Water Disposal. On January 4, 2002, the State of New Mexico approved the application for such action.

Due to the extraordinarily low gas prices, Calpine Natural Gas Company decided not to drill any wells in the area, which would produce water on-plate, to be disposed in the Roosevelt #1 SWD well. As a result, the well has not been converted to SWD.

Calpine Natural Gas Company anticipates drilling the well in 2003, which will require the conversion of the Roosevelt #1 to SWD.

Calpine Natural Gas Company respectfully requests a one-year extension of the approved application to convert the Roosevelt #1 to SWD.
