Gentlemen:

Marathon Oil Company hereby respectfully requests administrative approval to an exception to Rule 309-A to permit the commingling of production from two separate leases: the State Section "6" and the State K-5796. The production to be commingled is from one well on each lease, the State Section "6" No. 1 and the State K-5796 No. 1, which produce from a common source of supply, the Vacuum Abo, North oil pool.

Attached is a lease plat showing the wells on the leases and the formations in which they are completed. Also attached is a schematic diagram of the proposed diversified ownership commingling facility showing it to be of an acceptable design in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." This facility will permit the accurate measurement and determination of hydrocarbon production from each lease in accordance with the applicable provisions of the above manual.

All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production therefrom have consented in writing to the commingling.



Enclosed is one approved copy for your files. Please remit a Ten (\$10.00) Dollar filing fee.




MARATHON OIL COMPANY
