Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres production from your Shell State Lease comprising the S/2 NW/4 of Section 10, your Shell State "A" Lease comprising the S/2 NE/4 of Section 9, the SW/4 NE/4 and NW/4 SE/4 of Section 10, and your McLaughlin State Lease comprising the N/2 NW/4 of Section 10, all in Township 17 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Inasmuch as there is a variation in the ownership among these three leases, this type of commingling cannot be approved administratively.

You are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid three leases after separately metering the production, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the

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Commission at such time as this installation is complete in
order that an inspection may be made thereof.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the
transporter of this commingling authority.
