



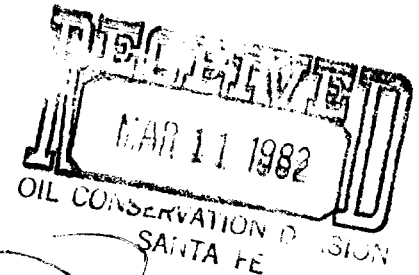

Gentlemen:

Application for Permission to Determine Commingled Production from the
Jack A-29 and Jack B-29 Leases by the Use of Well Tests

Surface commingling of Langlie Mattix Seven Rivers Queen production from the Jack A-29 and Jack B-29 Leases located in Section 29, T24S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico into a common battery facility was approved on August 18, 1970, Administrative Order No. CTB-214. Production from the Jack A-29 Lease is metered prior to commingling, and production from the Jack B-29 Lease is determined by the subtraction method.

Conoco Inc. now requests administrative approval as provided by Rule 309-B to determine commingled production on the basis of well tests as the production is of marginal nature. Average daily production from the Jack A-29 Lease and Jack B-29 Lease was 15 B0 and 23 B0, respectively, for the first two months of 1982.

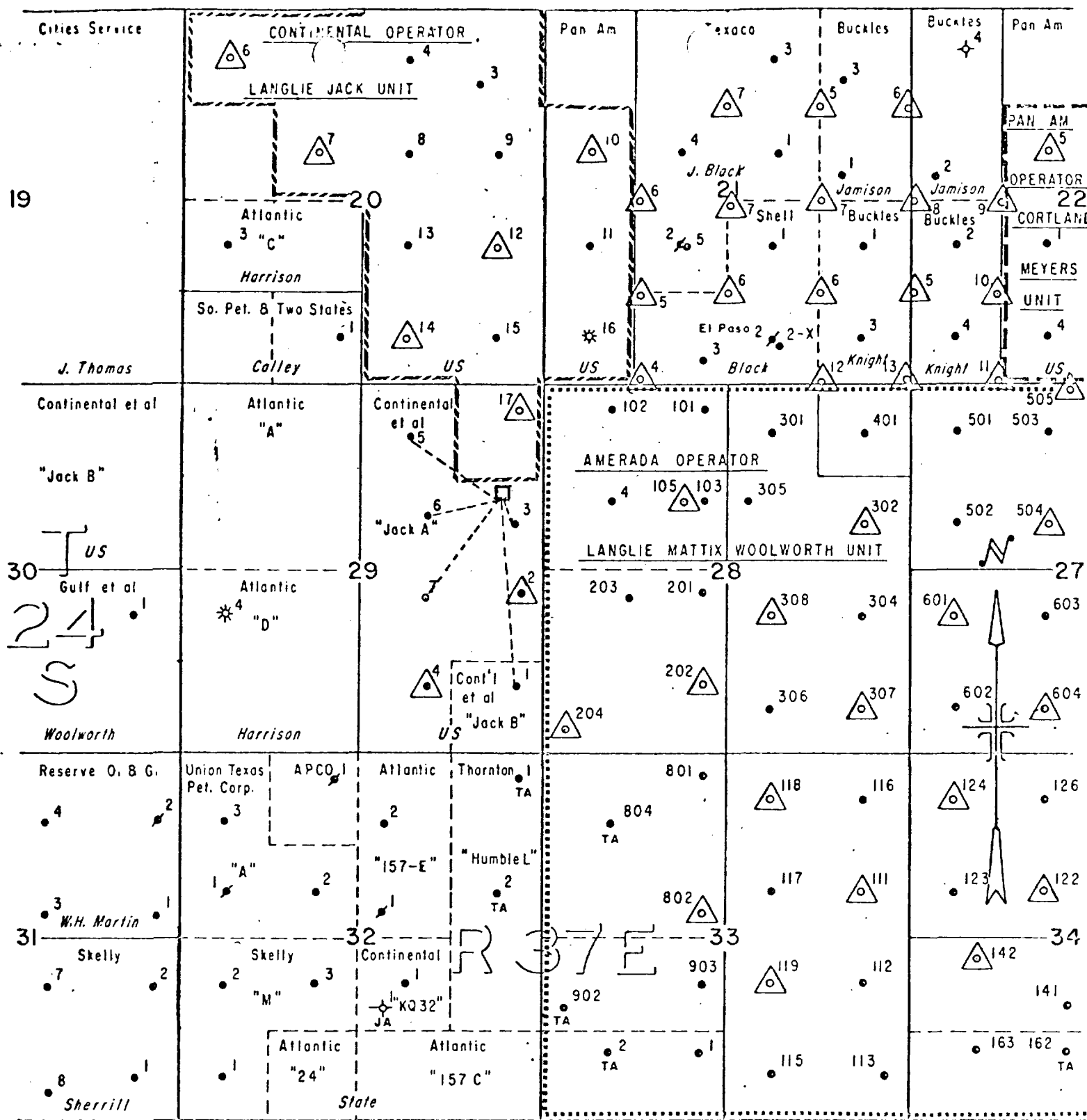

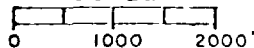
JACK A-29 & B-29 LEASES
