
Gentlemen:

Gentlemen:

Aztec Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests an exception to Rule 309 (A) and administrative approval to commingle San Andres oil production from the State "SS" and State "DS" leases located in Section 24, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, Spencer, San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

None of the wells on these leases is capable of producing top allowable. A Special Gas Oil Ratio Test is submitted herewith as evidence of the marginal status of the only producing well on the State "SS" lease. We propose to allocate production between leases on the basis of periodic well tests on this well and use the subtraction method from total production.

The following facts are pertinent to this request:

- (1) Aztec Oil & Gas Company is owner and operator of the above leases in which all working and royalty interests are common.
- (2) Both leases, State of New Mexico Lease Nos. L-199 and L-200, involve State land, therefore, evidence that the Commissioner of Public Lands has been advised of this request for commingling is attached to this application.
- (3) A schematic diagram of the proposed installation is attached.

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- (4) A plat showing the location of all wells on the leases involved is attached.
- (5) Since the production to be commingled is from a common source there will be no difference in gravity and price; therefore, value of production from the two leases will not change.

Your approval of this application will be greatly appreciated.

No well will be assigned an allowable greater than the amount of oil produced on the official test.
 During gas-oil ratio test, each well shall be produced at a rate not exceeding the top unit allowable for the pool in which well is located by more than 25 percent. Operator is encouraged to take advantage of this 25 percent tolerance in order that well can be assigned increased allowables when authorized by the Commission.
 Gas volumes must be reported in MCF measured at a pressure base of 15.025 psia and a temperature of 60° F. Specific gravity base will be 0.60.
 Report casing pressure in lieu of tubing pressure for any well producing through casing.
 Mail original and one copy of this report to the district office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in accordance with Rule 301 and appropriate pool rules.


