Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for and exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Grayburg-Jackson Pool Production by Shenandoah Oil Corporation on its Federal Lease No. LC 029020(a) covering the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 15, Federal Lease No. NM 0467930 covering the SW/4 EE/4 of section 15 and the N/2 N/2, E/2 NW/4, and NW/4 SW/4 of Section 22, and Federal Lease No. LC 029020(c) covering the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 15, all in Township 17 South, Range 30 East, N28W, Eddy County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that ownership of these three leases is identical throughout, and that you therefore propose to allocate the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Shenandoah is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the purchaser of this commingling authority.
