**Gentlemen:**

Reference is made to your application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Monument Grayburg-San Andres production from your State "K" Lease comprising the E/2 NW/4 of Section 29, your State "O" Lease comprising the NE/4 of Section 30, your State "P" Lease comprising the W/2 SW/4 of Section 29, and your State "R" Lease comprising the E/2 SW/4 of Section 29, all in Township 19 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production to each lease on the basis of quarterly well tests.

Inasmuch as the ownership of all four leases is not common, this method of commingling cannot be approved administratively.

Amerada Division will, however, be permitted to commingle the production from the aforesaid four leases after commingling the production from the "O", "P", and "R" Leases, separately metering this production, and separately metering the production from the "K" Lease, and you are hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production in the aforesaid manner, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
