The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle the following pools within acreage detailed below all located in Section 23, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

J. C. Gordon "C" No. 1 Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs (Gas 77200)	API No. 30-045-13237 NW/4 Dedication
J. C. Gordon "C" No. 2 Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs (Gas 77200)	API No. 30-045-06367 SW/4 Dedication
J. C. Gordon "D" No. 3 Angels Peak-Gallup (Associated 02170) Pool	API No. 30-045-13044 N/2 SW/4 Dedication
J. C. Gordon "E" No. 1 Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas 71629) Pool	API No. 30-045-26860 W/2 Dedication

Every well in this commingle shall have an allocation meter installed. Individual well gas sales, production, and BTUs shall be determined using these allocation meters, BTU analysis from every well, fuel gas usage, and the CDP volumes. **Compressor fuel gas usage shall be allocated according to well production rates.** Water and oil production shall not be commingled.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled natural gas production shall be delivered to a gas sales meter located on the lease.
