Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company requests administrative approval for off-lease storage of production from Well No. 3, State Lea #403 lease, South Vacuum Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. Well No. 3 is to be produced into a surplus tank battery with hydraulic equipment located on State Lea #405 lease.

Our State Lea #405 lease Well No. 1 is to be shut-in due to low productivity pending a study of possible remedial work and revised artificial lift equipment. When said Well No. 1 is restored to production, we anticipate making application to commingle this well's production into a battery with other Bone Spring production.

Should this application be approved, commingling of production of the two leases or from different formations will not result. There will be no inter-communication of the handling, separating, treating or storage facilities designated to each lease.

Attached please find a copy of letter to the Commissioner of Public Lands requesting his consent to the proposed off-lease storage on these leases both of which are located on State land. Also attached is an ownership plat in compliance with Statewide Rule 309-C.

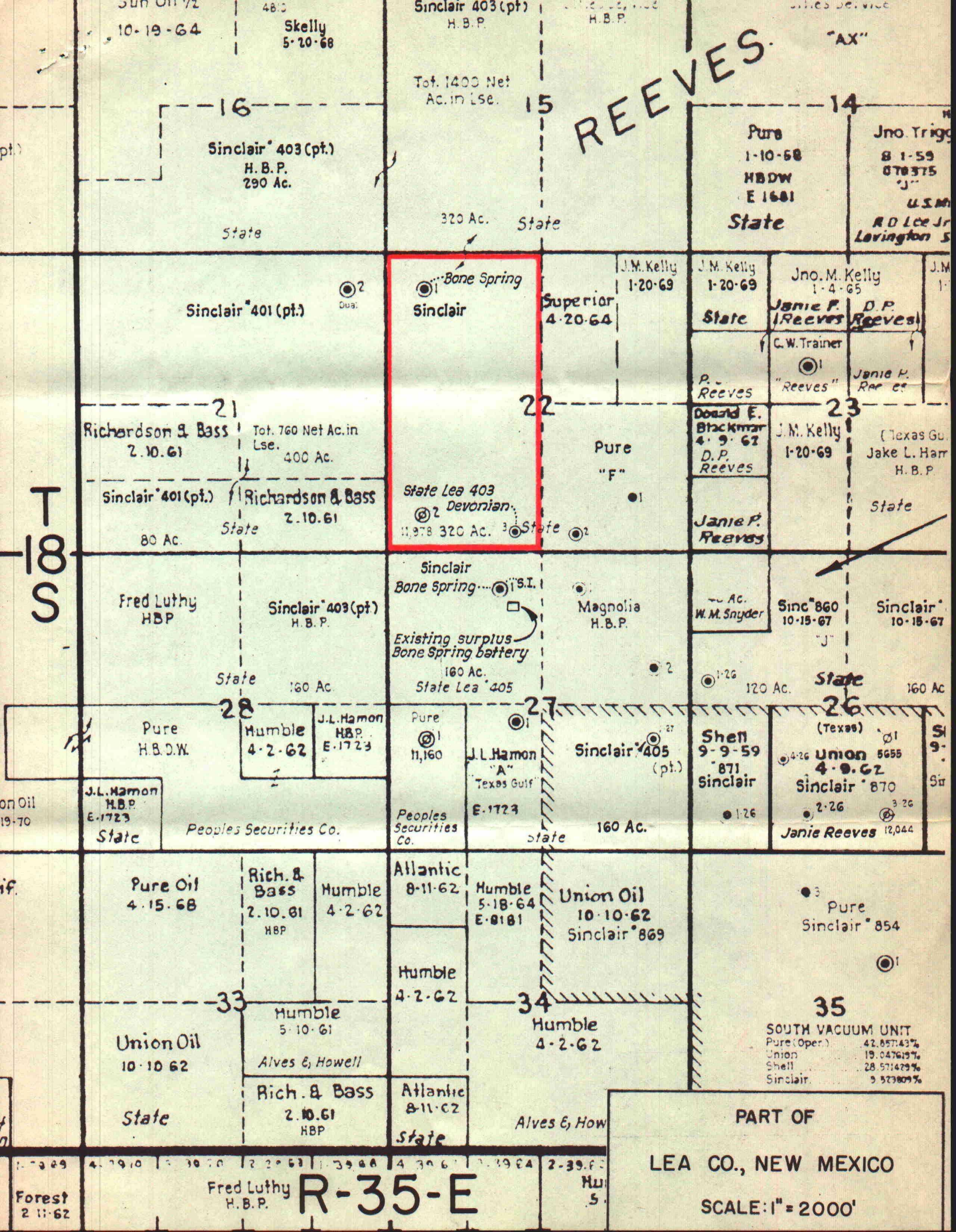

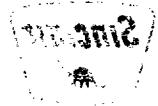


