Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of January 10, 1963, wherein you request authority to move oil produced from your KCL State "A" Lease comprising the NW/4 NW/4 Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 29 East, Round Tank San Andres Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico, prior to measurement and to measure and store the same in a separate tank battery on your KCL State "B" Lease in the NE/4 NW/4 of said Section 30.

It is our understanding that no commingling of the production from each of the two leases will occur, and that each lease will have separate treating and handling facilities.

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Rule 309 (c) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, off-lease storage for your State "A" Lease is hereby authorized as in the above manner.

For reasons which I will state below, we hereby respectfully request permission for off-lease storage facilities for our KCL-State A Lease, located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 29 East, Chaves County, New Mexico.

At present, we have rental tanks on this lease and wish to install permanent facilities.

In order to avoid extra costs of dirt work, we would like to utilize the tank pad and burn pits which now exist on our KCL-State B Lease, located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the same Section.

We propose to install a separate Heater-Treater and storage tank for the A lease. ³These facilities will not be connected to those of the B lease, and there will be no comingling of oil from the two leases.

Dear Mr. Bilberry:

We propose to request administrative approval for off-lease storage for our State-Bullis A lease, located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, T.15 S., R.29 E., Chaves County, New Mexico.

At present we have rental tanks on this lease and wish to install permanent facilities.

In order to avoid additional costs of dirt work, we wish to utilize the tank grade and burn pit which now exist on our KCL-State B lease, located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the same section. Also, in the light of future development, the site of the KCL-State B battery would be centrally located for a battery to accommodate several of these small leases, provided we had permission to comingle.

For the present, we propose to install a separate heater-treater and storage tank for the A lease not to be connected to the facilities of the B lease, and there will be no comingling of the oil from the two leases.

Attached is a plat of the leases involved showing the location of the wells and facilities. Also a diagram showing the existing B lease facilities and the proposed lease equipment.

If you consent to this proposal would you please so notify Mr. Nutter of the Oil Conservation Commission Office. We would also appreciate a call to our office in Midland on your decision.
