Gentlemen:

Phillips Petroleum Company requests an exception to NMOCC Rule  
No. 309(a) in regard to the lease described as follows:

Mexco "A" Lease - State Lease B-3610  
Section 1 and N/2 of Section 2, T17S, R32E,  
Lea County, New Mexico

Attached is a plat showing the above lease.

Prior to May 1, 1963, the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 2 was a part of the Mexco  
"A" lease; however, on that date, the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 2 was purchased  
by Phillips and the two 40-acre tracts were combined to form an 80-acre  
lease now designated as the Kennedy State Lease. The tank battery for  
the original Mexco "A" lease was located in the 40-acre tract (NE/4 SE/4  
Section 2) that is now included in the Kennedy State lease.

For economic reasons, an exception is now requested to Rule 309(a) for  
off-lease storage of the production from the present Mexco "A" lease.  
This lease consists of two wells, No. 1 and No. 3.

Separate tank batteries will be provided at the existing battery location  
for both the Kennedy State and Mexco "A" leases.


