Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of June 21, 1963, wherein you request authority to locate the tank battery for your Chalk Bluff Draw Well 3P which is located in Unit H of Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, at Humble Oil & Refining Company's battery site in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 9, Township 18 South, Range 27 East.

It is our understanding that you have only recently assumed operation of this well and desire this location for the battery to avoid extending the pipeline connection.

Pursuant to the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 309-C of the Commission Rules and Regulations, Pan American Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized the aforesaid off-lease storage, provided however, that there shall be no intercommunication of the handling, separating, treating, or storage facilities designated to this well and any other wells.

It is our understanding that you have already commenced operation of this well and desire this location for the battery to avoid extending the well connection.

Dear Sir:

On June 1, 1963, Pan American Petroleum Corporation assumed operation of Chalk Bluff Draw Well No. 3P located in Unit H, Section 8, T-18-S, R-27-E, Eddy County, New Mexico from Humble Oil and Refining Company (Humble's designation for this well was Abo Chalk Bluff Draw Unit Well No. 3P).

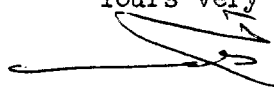
In order to avoid extending the pipe line connection, approval is requested to store production off the lease in a separate tank battery at Humble's battery site in the SE/4 NW/4, Section 9, T-18-S, R-27-E. In support of the above application, the following is submitted:

1. All production is from the same common source of supply.
2. There will be no commingling of production.
3. All separating, treating and storage facilities are separate and there will be no inter-communication of oil.
4. All parties owning an interest in this well have been furnished a copy of this application by certified mail in accordance with the attached mailing list.
