

Gentlemen:

This is the request of Standard Oil Company of Texas for administrative approval, in accordance with Statewide Rule 309-C, of off-lease storage for our Federal 12-5 Well No. 1, La Plata-Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The well is located in Unit N, Section 5, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, while the storage tanks are located in Unit D, Section 23, Township 31 North, Range 14 West. Standard Oil Company of Texas and the United States Department of the Interior are the only owners of interest in the lease on which the well is located. The storage tanks are located on unleased Ute Mountain Tribal Indian land. The Department of the Interior has approved off-lease storage, and a copy of their letter of approval is attached. Rights-of-way for the pipe line between the well and the tank battery have been secured. A plat showing well and tank battery locations is attached.

There are no other wells in the La Plata-Gallup Pool, nor is production to be commingled with production from any other well. The tank battery has been located at the nearest pipe line connection of the transporter, Shell Oil Company, thereby eliminating trucking expenses.

Approval of this request will allow a more efficient operation of the lease and a greater ultimate recovery of oil.

Your letter states that such off-lease storage would make a pipeline connection more economical and allow a more efficient operation of the lease.


The method you propose is hereby approved subject to like approval by appropriate officials of the State of New Mexico.


