Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated March 24, 1965, wherein you request off-lease storage authority for the Tobac-Pennsylvanian production from your Humble State B Lease which comprises the N/2 SW/4 of Section 21, Township 8 South, Range 33 East, Chaves County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the tank battery for said Humble State B Lease would be in Unit M of Section 21 on your Humble State A Lease which comprises the S/2 SW/4 of Section 21.

Inasmuch as all production is from the same common source of supply, commingling of production from the two leases will not result, and there will be no intercommunication of the handling, separating, treating, or storage facilities designated to each lease, the aforesaid off-lease storage is hereby approved.

We would like to make application for off-lease storage for our Humble State B Lease production.


