Franklin, Aston > Fair, Inc. recently drilled the Brigham H-1 well deeper to a total depth of 3,457.02 ft, and completed it in the San Andres Formation. The well is located 2,340 ft. from the south line and 330 ft. from the west line of section 21, waship 17 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

We are now preparing to set a tank battery for this well. It will be Lorprised of two-250 barrel tarks. You will note on the attached plat that the Brigham H-I well is located in the Loco Hills townsite and is in close proximity to owellings.
