The purpose of this letter is to request off lease storage for my Nancy #4 Well, Federal Lease #NM-0557389, to produce in existing tank facilities that the Escrito Gallup Unit #2, Communitized 14-08-0001-8691, well formerly produced into. The Escrito Gallup Unit #2 well has been abandoned and the Nancy #4 Well will be the only well producing into this battery.

This permit to produce in tank facilities on another lease will save the operator substantial money and at the same time will give the same production history as if it was producing into tanks on its same lease in that it will be the only well producing in this battery.

The United States Geological Survey in Roswell approved this off lease storage per their letter of April 11, 1967.

Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is to request off lease storage on my Nancy #4 Well, NM-0557389, located in Unit F, Sec. 12 T24N, R8W, in facilities formerly used by The Escrito Gallup Unit Well #2, 14-08-0001-8691, located in Unit O, Sec. 12, T24N, R8W.

The Escrito Gallup Unit #2 Well has been temporarily abandoned and it will save considerable expense to myself if this permission is granted. The Nancy #4 Well will be the only well producing into this facility and there will be no co-mingling of oil. Storage of the Unit #2 Battery on April 1, 1967, was 90.31 barrels which if this approval is granted I will expect to pay the Escrito Gallup Unit for at the field posted price of \$2.80 or \$252.87.

A xerox copy of this proposed off lease storage is shown on the attached plat.




