Reference is made to your application dated June 27, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A to permit off-lease storage for Baum-Upper Pennsylvanian production from your State 1 Well No. 1, located in Unit H of Section 1, Township 14 South, Range 32 East, and your State 6 Well No. 3, located in Unit L of Section 6, Township 14 South, Range 33 East, Baum-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. Gentlemen:

Coastal States Gas Producing Company is requesting administrative approval for off-lease storage for the State "1" Well No. 1 located in the NE/4 of Section 1, T-12-S, R-33-E, and the State "6" Well No. 3 located in the SW/4 of Section 6, T-13-S, R-33-E, Lea County, New Mexico, in that we be permitted to construct permanent storage and treating facilities at the location shown on the attached plat.

Coastal States is requesting that we be allowed to transport production prior to measurement from one lease to another lease for storage. The storage facilities for these two leases will be located as shown on the attached plat. If you will need additional information for approval, please advise.

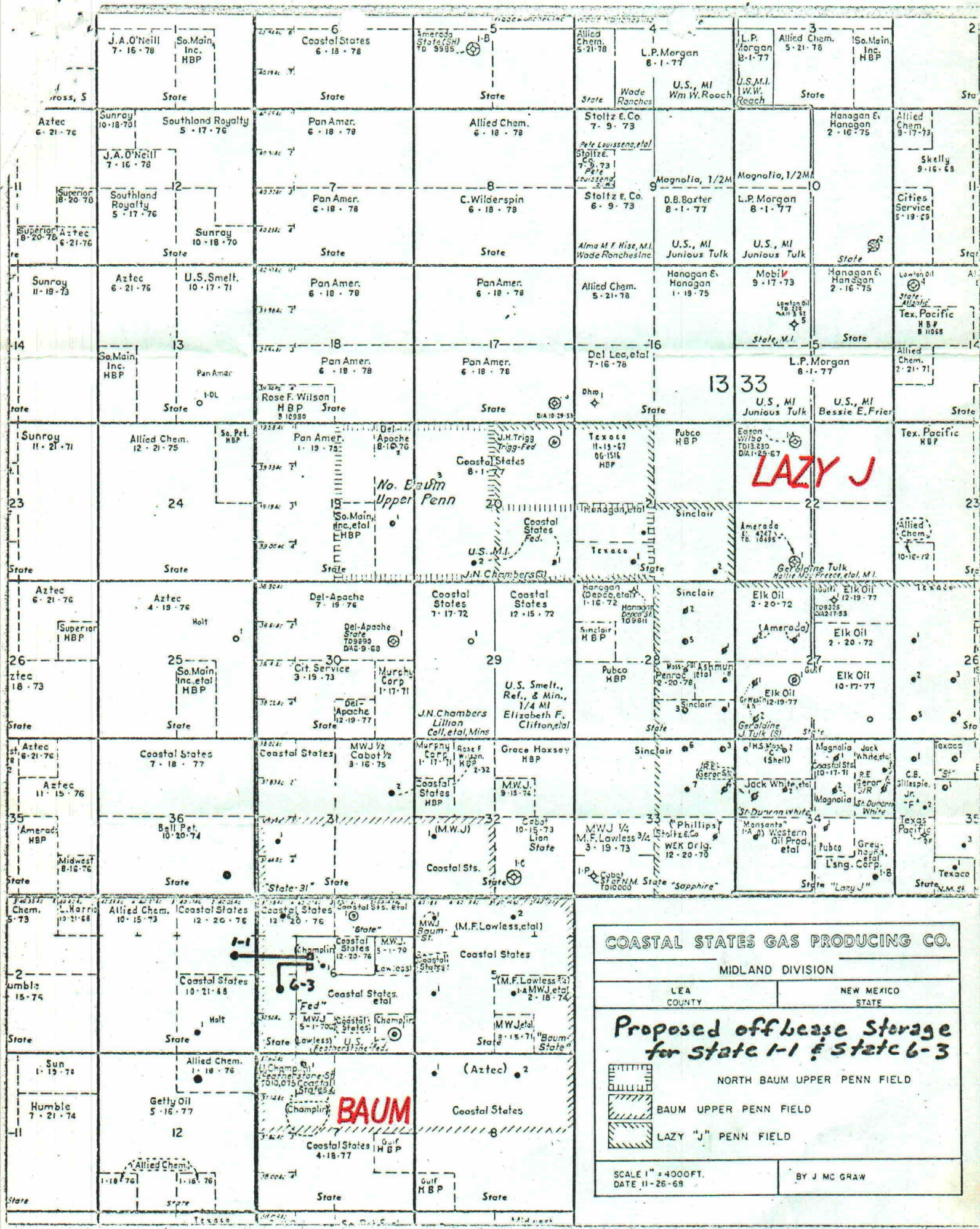

SCALE 1" = 4000 FT. DATE 11-26-69

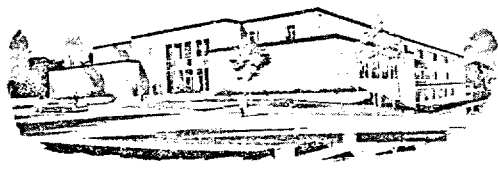
