

Gentlemen:

In accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 309-C, Texaco Inc. respectfully requests approval of an exception to Rule 309-A to permit off-lease storage of hydrocarbon production from the Teague Blinbry Pool from Texaco's New Mexico 'DC' State Lease into the battery on the New Mexico 'BZ' State NCT-8 Lease.


At the present time oil is being transported by truck from the New Mexico 'DC' Lease and upon approval of this application, a flowline will be installed from the 'DC' Lease to a pipeline connection at the 'BZ' tank battery, thus eliminating trucking of the oil.

The proposed off-lease storage will not result in commingling of production from the two leases. There will be no intercommunication of the handling, separating, treating, or storage facilities designated to each lease. A schematic of the proposed commingling installation and a plat of the subject leases are attached.

The State Land Office as Royalty Interest Owner is being furnished a copy of this application. Also attached is a copy of a letter to the State Land Office requesting their approval of this application.

Your cooperation in this matter will be appreciated.


