

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit production from your Citgo-State "B" Lease located in Unit O of Section 36, Township 8 South, Range 28 East, Chaves County, New Mexico, to be transported prior to measurement to a separate tank battery on your O'Brien "C" Lease located in Unit D of Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 28 East.

Pursuant to the authority granted me by Rule 309-C, Twinlakes Oil Company is hereby authorized off-lease storage as described above, provided that there shall be no inter-communication of the handling, separating, treating or storage facilities designated to each lease.



Gentlemen:

Twinlakes Oil Company seeks an exception to Rule 309-A to permit the production from its Citgo-State "B" lease located in Unit O of Section 36, Township 8 South, Range 28 East, Chaves County, New Mexico, to be transported prior to measurement to its O'Brien "C" lease located in Unit D of Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 28 East, Chaves County, New Mexico for storage thereon. The ownership of the Citgo-State "B" lease is as follows:

1. Twinlakes Oil Company is the operator with no present ownership. Donald G. Stevens is the owner of a sub-lease amounting to 79.296875% working interest of the 87.5% total working interest.
2. Cities Service Oil Company is the owner of an overriding royalty interest amounting to 8.203125% of the 87.5% working interest.
3. The State of New Mexico is the owner of a 12.500% royalty interest.

The ownership of the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 28 East, Chaves County, New Mexico is as follows:

1. Twinlakes Oil Company is the owner of an 87.5% working interest lease (100% of the working interest).

Enclosed is a plat showing the wells on the leases and the formations in which completed and the proposed location of the tank battery. Application further states that:

1. All production is from the same common source of supply.
2. Comingling of production from the two leases will not result.
3. There will be no intercommunication of the handling, separating, treating, or storage facilities designated to each lease.
4. All parties owning an interest in the leases have consented in writing to the off-lease storage or will consent in writing to the off-lease storage or have been mailed registered certified mail of the Twinlakes' intent to transport as set out herein. Evidence of the above will be furnished the Commission shortly.
5. State lands are involved and evidence will be furnished that the Commissioner of Public Land will consent to the proposed off-lease storage.



Gentlemen:

Enclosed are completion reports on the Twinlakes Oil Company Citgo-State "B" No. 1 well which is the second well drilled and completed under the terms of that certain farmout contract between Cities Service and Donald G. Stevens, dated August 27, 1973, and amended by letters of September 11, 1973 and January 31, 1974.

Under the terms of said farmout contract Donald G. Stevens is entitled to the assignment as set forth therein since the well has been completed as a producer of oil and gas under said terms. I would appreciate your forwarding to Donald G. Stevens said assignment at your earliest convenience.


Also enclosed is a copy of an application for off-lease storage directed to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission whereby production from this well will be transported to and stored in a presently existing tank one-quarter mile southwest. This tank is now empty, flow lines have been laid, and construction of a new battery for this relatively weak well would be prohibitively expensive. Inasmuch as a twenty day waiting period is required by the Commission unless you agree in writing to the off-lease storage, I would appreciate your immediate approval of said off-lease storage by executing in the lower left-hand corner and returning a copy to me immediately. Should it be necessary to wait the full twenty day period there is a possibility we will run out of storage and be forced to shut-in the well.


