Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated October 15, 1975, for administrative approval for the off-lease storage of Eagle Creek-San Andres production from your Yates Fee DT Lease and your Smith Fee EB Lease, both located in the NW/4 of Section 13, Township 17 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that these leases are located in or near to populated areas and that you propose to transport the production of each lease, prior to measurement, to its own tank battery to be located on your Achen Fry DM Lease in Unit I of Section 14 of the same township.

Off-lease storage for each of the subject leases is hereby authorized as described above, provided that there shall be no intercommunication of the handling, separating, treating, or storage facilities designated to any of the three concerned leases.

Re: Off Lease Storage, Eagle Creek (San Andres) Pool

Dear Sir:

Under the provisions of OCC Rule 309C, Yates Petroleum Corporation seeks administrative approval for an exception to OCC Rule 309A whereby production from our Yates Fee DT lease and Smith Fee EB lease may be transported by pipeline prior to measurement to individual tank batteries to be located on our Achen Frey DM lease in Unit I of Section 14-17S-25E.

The DT and EB leases are in the City of Artesia but the DM lease is outside of the city limits and approximately one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) mile from the nearest residence. All leases concerned have San Andres completions only with sour crude and gas production. The DT lease has a tank battery now in Unit L of Section 13-17S-25E and will be moved. The EB lease is located in Unit K of Section 13-17S-25E and has no battery yet.

1. All production is from the same common source;
2. Commingling of production will not result;
3. There will be no intercommunication of the handling, separating, treating, or storage facilities designated to each lease;
4. Yates Petroleum is the sole working interest for all leases concerned;
5. Ownership plats of the leases are attached.

This exception is asked primarily out of courtesy to the citizens of Artesia who from time to time would be exposed to pungent sour crude odors; also relocation of the several storage facilities outside the city limits will lessen the environmental impact with respect to public safety, fire hazard, noise and air pollution.
