AMENDED COMMINGLING ORDER PC-4

DESCRIPTION: N/2 NW/4, E/2, Section 18, Township 22 South, Range 38 East,
NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Blinebry, Tubb, Drinkard and Wantz Granite Wash Pool production in a common tank battery and to determine the production from each pool by well tests. (All commingled production must be of marginal nature; further, the operator shall notify the Santa Fe office of the Division in the event any well in the commingled battery becomes capable of top allowable production, at which time the Division will amend this order or take such other action as may be appropriate.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: This amended order authorizes the commingling of Wantz Granite Wash Pool production with the previously authorized Blinebry, Tubb and Drinkard Pool production.

Gentlemen:

Texaco Inc. respectfully requests permission to amend the current surface commingling authority to include production from the Wantz Granite Wash Formation. A newly drilled well, C. H. Lockhart (NCT-1) No. 11-D Sec. 18, T-22S, R-38E was completed in the Wantz Granite Wash Formation and tested 33 BOPD, 37.0 gravity and 35 MCFPD. It is further requested to retain the current well test method (outlined in administrative order PC-4) to allocate production as no well is capable of producing top allowable from any respective pool.




