Amendment  
Administrative Order PC-4

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated September 22, 1964, wherein you advise that all production currently being handled by the commingling installation authorized by Administrative Order PC-4 is now of marginal nature. Administrative Order PC-4 authorized the commingling of Brinkard, Tubb, and Slatney production on your C. H. Lockhart (MCT-1) Lease, Los County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production. Inasmuch as the production is now marginal, you wish to commingle the same without separate measurement, allocating the production to each of the various pools on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-4 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of the aforesaid production on the basis of periodic well tests, provided however, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the pools is capable of top allowable production.
