Reference is made to your application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303(a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the Grayburg oil and the McKee condensate produced through wells on your J. R. Phillips lease comprising the NE/4 of Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
