5. Attached is a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed installation.

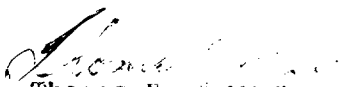

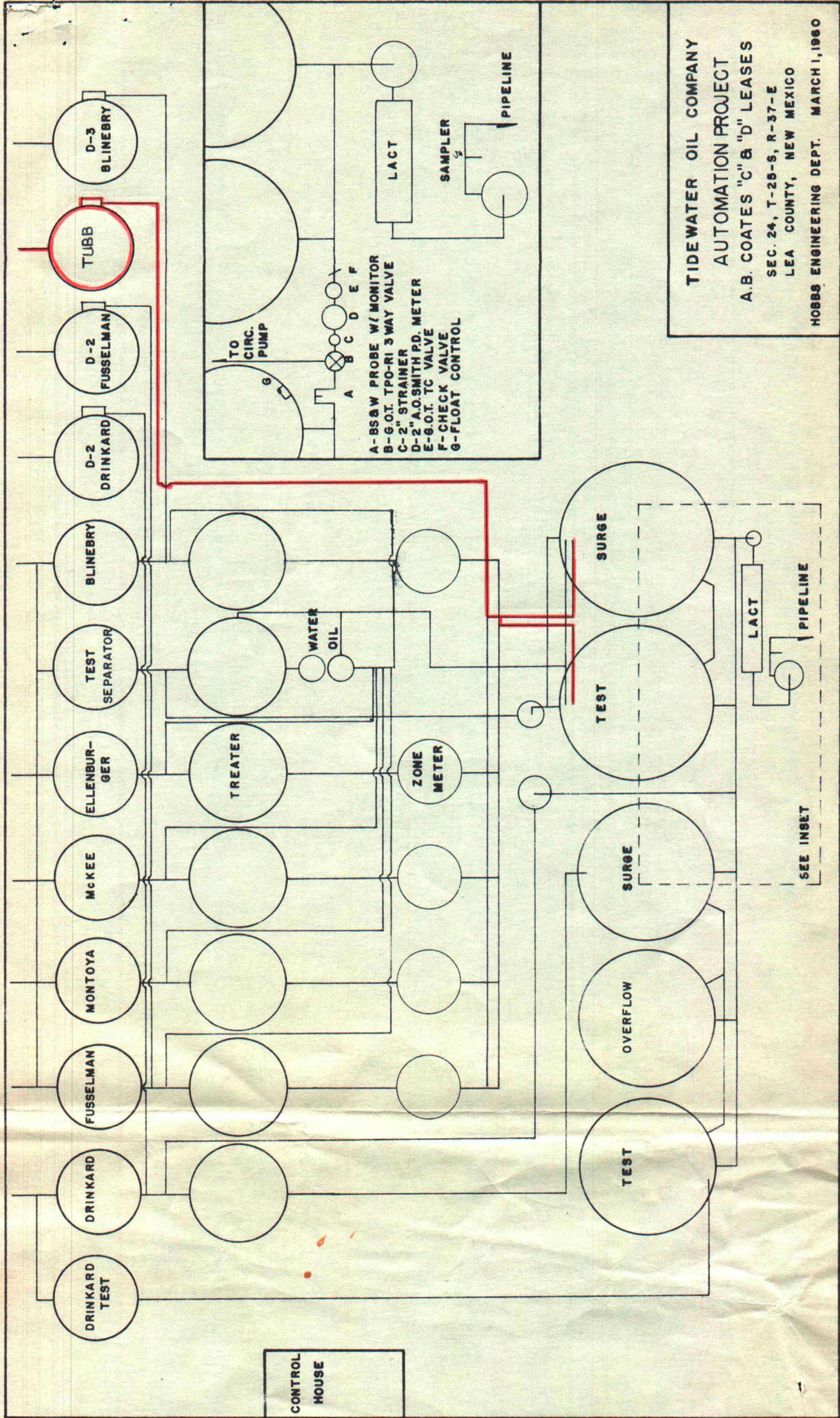

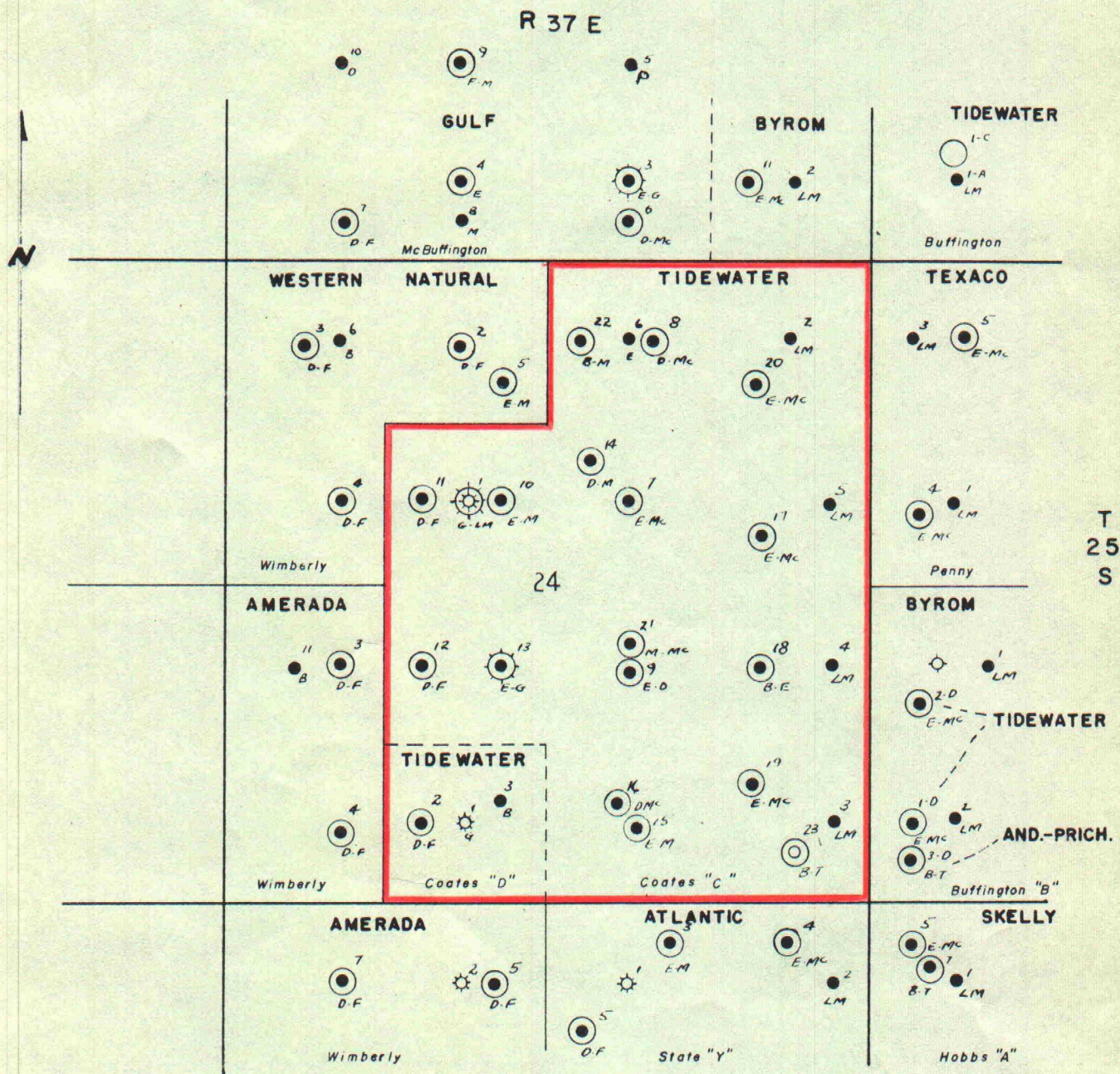
