Administrative Order PC-29

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated August 26, 1964, wherein you request that Administrative Order PC-29, which authorizes the commingling of Blincoy, Tubb, and Brinkard production on your A. H. Blincoy (NCT-1) Lease, comprising the 1/2 1/2 and 1/2 1/4 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 30 East, Lea County, New Mexico, be amended to include the 1/2 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 30 East, in the commingling authority.

Inasmuch as the 1/2 of said Section 20 is a portion of the aforesaid A. H. Blincoy (NCT-1) Lease, Administrative Order PC-29 is hereby amended to include this acreage. In all other respects Administrative Order PC-29 will remain in full force and effect.
