COMPANT SEEKING ADMINISTRATION APPROVAL FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWISE RULE 303(a) AS PER-TAINING TO COMMINGLING OF OIL FROM POOLS APTER SEPARATELY METERING THE OIL PRODUCTION ON

APPLICANT'S LAS CRUCES "C" LEASE

TO: THE HONORABLE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO

Comes now the applicant, Skelly Oil Company, and respectfully alleges and states as follows:

- In that it is the owner and operator of its las Cruces "C" Lease, which consists of the SW/4 NE/4 Section 23, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2. That there is no diversity of royalty exmership underlying the above descrited lease.
- 3. That the applicant is drilling one well which is to be dually completed in the Justia Blinebry oil pool and Justia Tubb-Drinkard oil pool.
- 4. That the applicant proposes to commingle production from the two pool after separate metering of the oil production from both pools.
- 5. That adequate testing facilities will be installed to accurate testing of the well and meters.
- 6. Attached hereto is a plat of the area showing the location of applicant's well and offset operators who has been notified with a copy of this request by registered mail.
 - 7. Attached hereto is a dismestic sketch of the tank battery.
- 8. The Justic Blinebry pool is expected to produce 44 BOPD of 38.6° Gravity Grade which will sell for 22.97 per barrel.
- 9. The Justice Tubb-Drinkard prol is expected to produced 44 BOPD of 41° Gravity Crude which tall sell for 3.01 per barrel.
- 10. The commingled production is expected to be 88 BOFD of 39.8° Gravity Crude which will sell for 2.99 per barrel.
- 11. The price of the commingled crude will be the same as the total price of the separate crudes and will have a shorter weathering time.

Therefore, so that undue hardship will not be enforced, Skelly Oil Company requests that the Secretary of the Commission administratively grant an exception to Statewade Rule 303 (a), so as to permit commingling in common storage after separately metering the oil production from both pools.
