Amendment to Administrative Order PC-35

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated May 13, 1965, requesting an amendment to Administrative Order PC-35 which authorized the commingling of Eumont, Penrose Skelly, and Drinkard production on your C. P. Falby "a" Lease comprising the NW/4 of Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

It is our understanding that all production on this lease is now of marginal nature, and that you therefore wish to commingle, allocating the production to each pool on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-35 is hereby amended to delete the metering requirement, provided however, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.
