Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of April 23, 1967, concerning the commingling installation authorized by Administrative Orders DC-37 and CTD-70, dated October 16, 1961, as amended December 21, 1961, and June 26, 1962. This order, as amended, authorizes the commingling of Blinbry, Brinkard, Devonian, and Fusselman production on your State "JM" and "JP" leases in Section 3, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, MDM, Los County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. It is our understanding that both of said leases constitute a portion of New Mexico State Lease No. B 1147 and that metering between the leases is therefore not necessary. Further, that the production was top allowable at the time of the issuance of the orders and the same metering was therefore required, but that the leases have now declined to a marginal nature.

Administrative Orders DC-37 and CTD-70 are hereby cancelled.
This order, Administrative Order PIC-26, authorizes the commingling

and the same, but with a larger body of water to the west of the original
stream which has been cut through the limestone by the river. The limestone out-
crop is 15 miles long and 1000 feet wide. The stream bed is 30-40 feet T.C.-T.S.
and meanders between 40-1000 feet east and west. The soil has, like
the underlying limestone, a reddish brown, siliceous, granular texture
of glacial origin, 5-10 inches at stream "T.C." but "T.S." about 1000 to 2000
feet above sea level, yellow soil above, less than 1000 ft above, brown
silicate rock 1000 ft or more above sea level, and limestone
outcrop occurs near the surface, a thin limestone layer lies to the east and
underneath it is sand. The weathered portion lies 100 ft below the soil and
is yellowish green with some reddish brown and yellow material. The weathered
soil contains many fine sand particles and is the most abundant soil to exist and
is of benefit both over stream and land and, perhaps, especially
where the soil is
