Administrative Orders PC-37 and CTS-70

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of April 28, 1967, concerning the commingling installation authorized by Administrative Orders PC-37 and CTS-70, dated October 16, 1961, as amended December 21, 1961, and June 26, 1962. This order, as amended, authorizes the commingling of Blinabry, Brinkard, Devonian, and Fusselman production on your State "JM" and "JP" Leases in Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N27N, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. It is our understanding that both of said leases constitute a portion of New Mexico State Lease No. B 1147 and that metering between the leases is therefore not necessary. Further, that the production was top allowable at the time of the issuance of the orders and the same metering was therefore required, but that the leases have now declined to a marginal nature.

Administrative Orders PC-37 and CTS-70 are hereby cancelled. This order, Administrative Order PLC-26, authorizes the commingling

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of April 22, 1957, concerning the cancelling of certain orders authorized by Administrative Orders PC-37 and CTS-10, dated October 16, 1951, as amended December 11, 1951, and June 10, 1952. This order, as amended, authorizes the cancellation of leases, including, but not limited to, leases in your State "J" and "K" leases in Section 17, Township 13 South, Range 17 East, Tarrant County, New Mexico, after separately stating the production from each pool. It is our understanding that both of said leases constitute a portion of New Mexico State Lease No. 5157 and that the production from the same is therefore not necessary. Further, that the production was not allowable at the time of the issuance of the order and the same ordering was therefore required, but that the leases have now declined to a marginal nature.
