Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated October 23, 1961, for administrative approval for an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Denton-Wolfcamp and Denton-Devonian pools on your W. T. Mann "B" Lease located in Section 36, Township 14 South, Range 37 East, New Mexico, New Mexico, without separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the Denton-Wolfcamp and Denton-Devonian Pools on the above-described W. T. Mann "B" Lease without separately metering the production from each pool; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further however, that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such time as any well in either pool is capable of top allowable production.
